Consultations were carried out from June to September 2024.

This was to find out what people think is important for monitoring in day services.

Communication worked on the consultations and looked at what people had to say.



Consultation Feedback with People Supported



78 participants were asked:

 What they like about day services and what needs to be better.



- What information they would like to get before an assessor visits.
- How they would like to be included in the monitoring process.



Participants suggested questions they felt the assessor should ask during a monitoring visit.

Consultation Feedback with Families



Families were asked to fill out a survey about the monitoring process.

1,800 surveys were received.

Consultation Feedback with Staff



96 staff, working in day services, talked about:

- How important it is to get to know people well and listen to them.
- What works well in day services and what could be improved.



Staff believe monitoring will make services better.

Consultation Feedback with Organisational Leads



Every organisation has 1 staff responsible for New Directions Interim Standards.

This person is called an Organisational Lead.





- Thought it was good that the assessor will review documents about the service before the visit. This is called a desktop review.
- Would like to know what documents will be looked at before the visit.
- Thought the values behind the monitoring approach were good.
- Would like the assessors to have enough time to meet with people supported in day services.




Monitoring Trial



A monitoring trial will take place in a number of day services.

This will start before the end of 2024.



Each block will focus on a different area:

Practice Development Block: Training for the trial assessors



Trial Block 1: Desktop review and gathering information



Trial Block 2: Making decisions and reviewing information



Trial Block 3: Giving feedback and final reports.

When the trial is over, the NDA will write a final report.

This report will give advice on the best way to do monitoring.
