How do I pay a bill or rent from my bank account?

	<p>You can pay a bill from your bank account. For example, you could pay your electricity bill or mobile phone bill.</p>
	<p>You can also pay your rent from your bank account.</p>
	<p>Watch out for scams or fraud. This is when a person lies to you or tricks you to get money from your bank account.</p>



If you want to pay a bill or rent, here is what you need to do:



- Go to the bank. Each bank is called a branch.



- If you want, you can bring someone that you trust to support you.



- Bring your bank account number and photo identification.



- Decide how much money you need to pay.



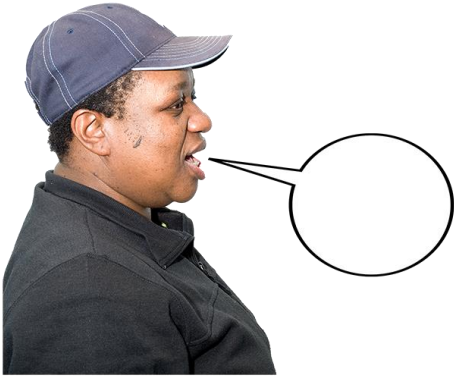
- Make sure you have enough money in your account to pay the bill, and have some money left for your own things.

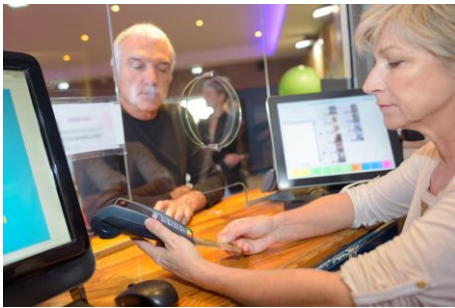
- Get the name and the bank account number of the person or company you want to pay. This account number is called the IBAN number.



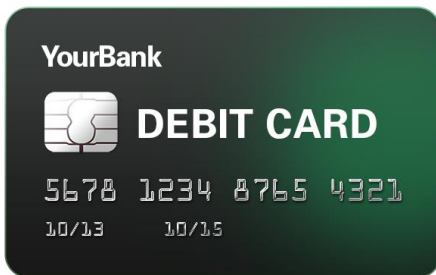
- Go to the counter in the bank. Give the person working at the counter this information.



- You might want to tell the bank what the payment is for so we can put this information with the payment.



- The person working at the counter will pay the bill for you.
They will send the money from your account to the other account.



- You can also use your bank card to pay a bill or rent from your account.



- Make sure you know the PIN number.
Never share your PIN number with anyone.
